When your family sits down to share God’s Word, use this devotion on its own or go to <https://davidccook.org/echoes/resources> to watch **Jesus Shows His Love** before doing the devotion together. This devotion works well in March.

In the video, the kids talk about different ways they can tell their families, friends, neighbors, and others about Jesus through their words and their actions.

- Who can you tell about Jesus and His love?
- How will you do that?

The Bible tells us many ways that Jesus showed love to those around Him. Jesus spent time with people, healed them, served them, and taught them about God.

- Can you name some other ways Jesus showed He loved people in the Bible?
- How does Jesus show that He loves you?
- Memorize Matthew 28:20 together. How is Jesus showing love in this verse?
- How does it make you feel to know Jesus is always with you?

End with a short prayer: Dear God, thank You for sending Jesus to show us how to love. Help us to show His love to others and to always remember that He is with us. May we learn to be more and more like Him. In Jesus’ name, amen.

Jesus' Friends Show His Love

Serve one another humbly in love.
Galatians 5:13

When your family sits down to share God's Word, use this devotion on its own or go to <https://davidccook.org/echoes/resources> to watch **Jesus' Friends Show His Love** before doing the devotion together. This devotion works well in April.

The kids in the video talk about different ways they can show Jesus' love to people around them—by helping them, encouraging them, sharing with them, and more!

- What are ways you can show Jesus' love to others?

Jesus' friends felt so loved by Him that they were overflowing with love too. And they let that love pour out onto everyone around them. We can do the same thing!

- Memorize Galatians 5:13 together.
- "Humbly" means to do something in a way that isn't proud. Why is that important?
- How can your family humbly show the love of Jesus to someone this week?

End with a short prayer: Dear God, thank You for Jesus and for the love He has shown each of us. Help our hearts to overflow with His love, so that others can come to know You. In Jesus' name, amen.



Unit 21

Jesus' Friends Help Others

Let us do good to all people.
Galatians 6:10

When your family sits down to share God's Word, use this devotion on its own or go to <https://davidccook.org/echoes/resources> to watch **Jesus' Friends Help Others** before doing the devotion together. This devotion works well in May.

The kids in the video talk about different ways they can help people around them. You don't have to be a grownup or have lots of money to help someone. Sometimes the smallest things mean the most! Whether in big ways or small, there are things each of us can do to help others.

- How can you help other people?

Jesus taught that we should help everyone—no matter who they are, what they look like, how they dress, how they talk, where they live, or how we feel about them. Every person matters to Jesus!

- Memorize Galatians 6:10 together.
- Why is it important that we do good things for everyone, not just our families and friends?
- How can your family reach out this week to do something good for someone you don't know?

End with a short prayer: Dear God, help us to remember that You love every single person and that you made each of us to be like You. Help us to treat everyone with love and to help others whenever we can. In Jesus' name, amen.
