God's Plan

Psalm 33:11

When your family sits down to share God's Word, use this devotion on its own or go to <https://davidccook.org/echoes/resources> to watch “God's Plan” before doing the devotion together. This devotion works well in December.

In the video, the kids talk about how God planned to send Jesus to earth to save us from the punishment for our sins.

- What is sin?
- How was Jesus' birth a part of God's plan?

The Bible tells us about Jesus, God's Son, who saved us all from our sins. God had a plan for Jesus, and God has a plan for you too!

- What are some plans God may have for you? How does that make you feel?
- Memorize Psalm 33:11. What does it mean that God's plans stand firm?
- How can you tell others the good news about God's plan to save us?

End with a short prayer: Dear God, thank You for the plans You have for us. Help us to follow You and to tell others about Your great love. Thank You for the gift of Your Son. In Jesus' name, amen.

Unit 17

Who Jesus Is

“All things are possible with God.”

Mark 10:27

When your family sits down to share God’s Word, use this devotion on its own or go to <https://davidccook.org/echoes/resources> to watch “Who Jesus Is” before doing the devotion together. This devotion works well in January.

The kids in the video explain who Jesus is, what He does, why He came to earth, and what that means to them.

- How would you explain who Jesus is?

The Bible tells about many miracles that Jesus did while He lived on earth. A miracle is something so extraordinary that it can’t be explained by anything other than God. Jesus performed miracles to show God’s power and to help people know how much God loves them. Jesus’ miracles showed people that God can do anything!

- Has your family ever experienced a miracle? If so, what was it like?
- Memorize Mark 10:27. How can this verse change the way you look at your everyday problems?
- What “impossible” problem or situation are you facing right now? Do you trust God to get you through it?

End with a short prayer: Dear God, thank You for miracles that remind us that You can do anything. Help us to always trust in Your power and Your love. In Jesus’ name, amen.

Unit 18

What Jesus Said

Love your neighbor as yourself.
Luke 10:27

When your family sits down to share God's Word, use this devotion on its own or go to <https://davidccook.org/echoes/resources> to watch "What Jesus Said" before doing the devotion together. This devotion works well in February.

The kids in this video talk about things that Jesus taught through His words and His actions. He taught us to put others first, to trust God, and to forgive.

- What are some other ideas that Jesus taught?

Jesus told stories to help us learn about how He wants us to live. He wants us to show and share His love by the things we do and say. He wants us to keep our word, to be kind, and to put others first. He told a story about a Samaritan man who did all these things.

- What does it mean to be a neighbor? Who is your neighbor?
- Memorize Luke 10:27. What can this verse help you to remember?
- As a family, what can you do to show a neighbor that they matter to God and to you?

End with a short prayer: Dear God, help us to always remember that You created every person and that You want us to treat each other with love. Remind us to be good neighbors in everything we do and say. In Jesus' name, amen.
