Jesus Shows His Love

All things are possible with God.
Mark 10:27

When your family sits down to share God's Word, use this devotion on its own or go to <https://davidccook.org/echoes/resources> to watch **Jesus Shows His Love** before doing the devotion together. Use this devotion anytime during March.

In the video, the kids talk about different ways they can tell their families, friends, neighbors, and others about Jesus through their words and their actions.

- Who can you tell about Jesus and His love?
- How will you do that?

The Bible tells us many ways that Jesus showed His love and power to those around Him. Jesus showed Peter he could trust Him, He healed people who were blind, He forgave a man for wrong things he'd done, and He even brought a man back to life! Jesus did things that only He could do to show how much He loves us.

- What are some other things that only Jesus can do?
- Memorize Mark 10:27 together. How do you feel knowing Jesus is more powerful than anything—including your problems and fears?
- What is one "impossible" situation you're facing? How can Jesus help?

End with a short prayer: Dear God, thank You for loving us and for showing that love in such amazing ways. Help us to always know that You are with us, no matter what we're facing. In Jesus' name, amen.

Unit 20

Jesus' Friends Show His Love

As I have loved you, so you must love one another.
John 13:34

When your family sits down to share God's Word, use this devotion on its own or go to <https://davidccook.org/echoes/resources> to watch **Jesus' Friends Show His Love** before doing the devotion together. Use this devotion anytime during April.

The kids in the video talk about different ways they can show Jesus' love to people around them—by helping them, encouraging them, sharing with them, and more!

- What are ways you can show Jesus' love to others?

Jesus' friends felt so loved by Him that they were overflowing with love too. And they let that love pour out onto everyone around them. We can do the same thing!

- Memorize John 13:34 together.
- Notice that Jesus uses the word *must*. He isn't asking us to love others; He's telling us. Why do you think loving others is so important?
- What other verses can you find in the Bible that talk about how we should treat one another?

End with a short prayer: Dear God, thank You for Jesus and for the love He has shown each of us. Help our hearts to overflow with His love, so that others can come to know You. In Jesus' name, amen.

Unit 21

Jesus' Friends Help Others

Serve one another humbly in love.
Galatians 5:13

When your family sits down to share God's Word, use this devotion on its own or go to <https://davidccook.org/echoes/resources> to watch **Jesus' Friends Help Others** before doing the devotion together. This devotion works well in May.

The kids in the video talk about different ways they can help people around them. You don't have to be a grownup or have lots of money to help someone. Sometimes the smallest things mean the most! Whether in big ways or small, there are things each of us can do to help others.

- How can you help other people?

Our attitudes make a big difference in everything we do. Sometimes we can do good things with bad attitudes (like clean our rooms but complain about it or "apologize" but not really mean it). Having the right attitude when we help others is important! The Bible tells us to behave humbly toward one another—meaning to act in a way that isn't proud or boastful.

- Memorize Galatians 5:13 together.
- Why is it important to be humble when you help someone else?
- Did Jesus behave humbly? Can you give some examples?
- How can you humbly serve someone this week?

End with a short prayer: Dear God, thank You for the gifts and abilities You give each of us so that we can serve those around us. As we do, help us to have an attitude of humility and love, as Jesus did. In Jesus' name, amen.
