

Tying the Video into the Lesson

Use these tie-ins to help connect the unit videos to each lesson.

Preschool

These tie-ins can be used as an introduction to the video. Show the video before telling the Bible story.

Unit 19: Jesus Shows His Love

Lesson 1: Before we learn about Jesus blessing the children, let's watch our video. Let's see what the children say about Jesus showing His love.

Lesson 2: Let's watch our video about Jesus showing His love. Our Bible story teaches that Jesus showed His love by healing two blind men.

Lesson 3: Before we hear about how Jesus washes the disciples' feet, let's watch our video. Look for ways that Jesus shows us how to love each other.

Lesson 4: Our video helps understand Jesus' love. Let's watch it before we hear Jesus teaches a story of two builders.

Palm Sunday: Today's Bible story talks about Jesus entering Jerusalem as King. Let's see what the kids in the video say about how Jesus shows His love.

Easter: Our Bible story teaches us about the ultimate way Jesus shows His love—by dying for our sins and rising again. Let's watch the video to discover what kid coach says about Jesus and His love.

Unit 20: Jesus' Friends Show His Love

Lesson 5: Before we hear our Bible story about how Peter and John help a lame man, let's watch our video. Look for ways the girls help the man and woman.

Lesson 6: Our video shows how Jesus' friends show His love. Let's watch it before we hear about how Philip showed Jesus' love to the Ethiopian man.

Lesson 7: In our video, the girls help by planting a flower bed. Let's watch to see how they show they love Jesus before we hear our Bible story of Paul and Silas help a jailor.

Unit 21: Jesus' Friends Help Others

Lesson 8: In our video, the children are with their mom at a food shelf. Let's watch how the children learn about Jesus from her. Then we'll learn how Timothy's mother and grandmother teach him about God.

Lesson 9: Today's Bible story talks about how the people in the church share with each other. Let's see how the kids in the video make each other happy by sharing.

Lesson 10: Before we hear our Bible story about how Dorcas helped others and Peter helped her, let's watch our video. Look for how one family prays for the other.

Lesson 11: Before we hear our Bible story about Lydia and Paul, let's watch our video to see how the children are nice to each other.

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Early Elementary

These tie-ins can be used as an introduction to the video. Show the video before introducing where the Bible story is on the Bible timeline and in the Bible.

Unit 19: Jesus Shows His Love

Lesson 1: Before we learn about Peter walking on water with Jesus, let's watch our video to see what it says about trusting Jesus.

Lesson 2: Let's watch our video about Jesus showing His love. Our Bible story teaches that Jesus showed His love by healing two blind men.

Lesson 3: Before we learn about Jesus forgiving Zacchaeus, let's watch our video to discover what our kid coach says about forgiveness.

Lesson 4: As we watch our video today, look for ways Jesus shows His love, then learn what the Bible says about Jesus using His all-powerful love to raise Lazarus.

Palm Sunday: Today's Bible story talks about Jesus entering Jerusalem as King. Let's see what the kids in the video say about how Jesus shows His love.

Easter: Our Bible story teaches us about the ultimate way Jesus shows His love—by dying for our sins and rising again. Let's watch the video to discover what kid coach says about Jesus and His love.

Unit 20: Jesus' Friends Show His Love

Lesson 5: Our video shows how Jesus' friends show His love. Let's watch it before we hear about how Philip showed Jesus' love to the Ethiopian man.

Lesson 6: Before we hear our Bible story about how Dorcas helped others and Peter helped her, let's watch our video. Look for how the girls help the man and woman.

Lesson 7: Let's watch our video. What are some different ways Jesus' friends show His love? Then we'll learn how the widows were helped in our Bible story.

Unit 21: Jesus' Friends Help Others

Lesson 8: In our video, the children are with their mom at a food shelf. Let's watch how the families help each other know about Jesus.

Lesson 9: Before we hear the story of how Peter tells Cornelius about Jesus, let's watch our video to see how the one family shows Jesus' love to another family.

Lesson 10: Before we hear our Bible story about how Barnabas and Paul worked together, let's watch our video to see how the children work together.

Lesson 11: Our Bible story teaches how Paul told his friends about Jesus. Let's watch the video to discover how the children show Jesus' love to their new friends.

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Elementary

These tie-ins can be used as an introduction to the video. Show the video before finding the Bible basis on the Bible Overview Chart and working through the Bible study.

Palm Sunday (Use the “Final Days of Jesus” video): Our Bible story teaches about Jesus warning, comforting, and praying for His disciples. Let’s watch our video to see how the boy understands Jesus’ message and actions.

Easter Sunday (Use the “Jesus Conquers Death” video): Before we hear our Bible story about Jesus coming alive on the third day, let’s watch our video to discover what the kids say about Jesus’ resurrection.

Ascension (Use the “Jesus Conquers Death” video): Let’s watch the video to see how the boy was comforted when he talked to his mom. Then we’ll hear our Bible story Jesus ascending into heaven and how He comforts us now and in the future.

Unit 19: Final Days of Jesus

Lesson 1: In today’s Bible story, Jesus shows how to serve others by washing His disciples’ feet. Let’s watch the video to discover the biggest way Jesus served others—including us!

Lesson 2: Our Bible story teaches about the Last Supper. As we watch our video, let’s see why Jesus died on the cross.

Unit 20: Jesus Conquers Death

Lesson 3: Before we hear about Jesus restoring Peter, let’s watch the video to see what the kids have to say about how Jesus restores us to God.

Lesson 4: Let’s watch the video to discover how much Jesus loves us. Then we’ll hear our Bible story about how Jesus gave Peter an important job that showed his love for Jesus.

Lesson 5: Let’s watch the video to see what the kids say about why Jesus’ resurrection is important to them. Then we’ll study what the Bible says about Stephen and what he said about Jesus.

Unit 21: How Believers Live

Lesson 6: Before we hear our Bible story about Peter and John healing a man, let’s watch our video. Look for why believing that Jesus rose from the dead affects others.

Lesson 7: Let’s watch the kids in our video to discover what they say about how to treat others before studying what happened in the early church in Jerusalem.

Lesson 8: Let’s watch a video about living as people who believe in Jesus’ resurrection. Then we’ll discover how Jesus brings Dorcas help others and was raised from the dead.

Lesson 9: Before we hear what God says about Peter and Cornelius, let’s watch a video to see what the kids say about how believing that Jesus rose from the dead affects how they treat others.

Lesson 10: In today’s Bible story, Peter is freed from prison. As we watch our video, let’s see what it says about how to live as a believer.

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Upper Elementary

These tie-ins can be used as an introduction to the video. Show the video before handing out *Bible Adventures* and working through the Bible study.

Palm Sunday (Use the “Final Days of Jesus” video): Our Bible study talks about Jesus praying in Gethsemane, His arrest, and His trial. Let’s watch our video to see how the boy understands Jesus’ message and actions.

Easter Sunday (Use the “Jesus Conquers Death” video): Let’s watch the video to see what the kids say about why Jesus’ resurrection is a big deal. Then we’ll study Jesus’ death and resurrection.

Unit 19: Final Days of Jesus

Lesson 1: In today’s Bible study, Jesus talks about caring for His followers. Let’s watch the video to discover what the boy learns about how much Jesus cares for them and us.

Lesson 2: Our Bible study teaches about Jesus, the Good Shepherd, who willingly lays down His life. As we watch our video, let’s see how that ties in with the boy’s questions for his mom.

Lesson 3: Before we hear Jesus’ proclamation that He was the Messiah as He entered Jerusalem on a donkey, let’s watch the video to see what the kids have to say about why Jesus chose to die on the cross.

Unit 20: Jesus Conquers Death

Lesson 4: Let’s watch the video to discover how the boy serves his family to pay for a broken window. Then we’ll study what the Bible says about Jesus teaching His disciples, and us, about serving others.

Lesson 5: Let’s watch the video to see what it shows about forgiveness. Then we’ll study what the Bible says about Peter betraying Jesus and how Jesus forgave him.

Lesson 6: Let’s watch the kids in our video to discover what the boy learned about Jesus before studying Peter and how *he* grew stronger in his faith.

Unit 21: How Believers Live

Lesson 7: Let’s watch the kids in our video to discover what they say about how to treat others before studying what happened in the early church in Jerusalem.

Lesson 7: Before our Bible study about the Holy Spirit and Pentecost, let’s watch our video. Look for how the Holy Spirit works in the lives of the kids.

Lesson 8: Let’s watch a video about living as people who believe in Jesus’ resurrection. Then we’ll discover how the Holy Spirit helps Peter and two people.

Lesson 9: Before we hear what happened to Ananias and Sapphira, let’s watch a video to see what the kids say about how believing that Jesus rose from the dead affects how they treat others.
