These tie-ins can be used as an introduction to the video. Show the video before finding the Bible basis on the Bible Overview Chart and working through the Bible study.

Unit 28: Willing to Serve

Lesson 1: We can love God by getting ready for Jesus' birthday. Let's watch our video before we learn how Zechariah and Elizabeth were willing to prepare for Jesus' birth.

Lesson 2: Jesus came as a Savior to everyone! Before we learn what an angel told Mary about Jesus, let's watch our video.

Lesson 3: The shepherds served God by eagerly sharing the news of Jesus' birth. Before we learn more about the shepherds, let's watch our video.

Lesson 4: Our video helps us remember what happened when Jesus was born. Let's watch it before we learn how the wise men brought gifts to Jesus.

Unit 29: Ready to Serve

Lesson 5: Before we learn how Paul became Jesus' helper, let's watch our video. Let's notice the different ways people can learn about Jesus.

Lesson 6: We can obey Jesus and tell others about His love. Before we learn how Paul and Barnabas shared the good news of Jesus, let's watch our video.

Lesson 7: Jesus helps missionaries serve God as they tell of His good news! Before we learn how God gave power to Paul and Barnabas, let's watch our video.

Lesson 8: We can pray for missionaries today as they help others believe in Jesus! Before we learn about the evangelistic efforts of Paul and Silas, let's watch our video.

Lesson 9: Let's watch our video. Then we'll learn what Paul did to help Christians grow stronger in their faith.

Unit 30: Power to Serve

Lesson 10: Being a missionary can be challenging! Let's watch our video before we learn how Jesus helped Paul to be brave as a missionary.

Lesson 11: Even in difficult times, God is with His people. Let's watch our video before we learn how God was with Paul in a difficult situation.

Lesson 12: We can serve God by giving to His work around the world. Before we learn about bringing offerings to God, let's watch our video.

Lesson 13: Whether you are a missionary overseas or in your hometown, you can be a good worker for Jesus. Let's watch our video before we learn how John Mark learned to be a missionary.

Upper Elementary

These tie-ins can be used as an introduction to the video. Show the video before handing out *Bible Adventures* and working through the Bible study.

Unit 28: Willing to Serve

Lesson 1: Jesus can make us into new people! Before we learn how Saul became Paul, let's watch our video.

Lesson 2: Before we learn how Paul was willing to be used by God, let's watch our video. Let's see how the students choose to serve Jesus.

Lesson 3: The good news of Jesus is for everyone. Before we learn how Paul shared this good news of Jesus' birth, let's watch our video.

Lesson 4: Sometimes following Jesus can be difficult. Let's watch our video, noticing the ways that people love Jesus and serve others—even when it requires work!

Lesson 5: Before we learn how Paul courageously told people about Jesus, let's watch our video. Let's notice the different ways people can learn about Jesus.

Lesson 6: God is always with us, and He helps us with difficult tasks. Before we learn how God was always with Paul, let's watch our video.

Lesson 7: True strength and power come from God. Let's watch our video before learning how Paul shared God's Word with people who believed in false power.

Lesson 8: Let's watch our video before we learned how Paul trusted God in big ways.

Lesson 9: We should always be ready to tell others about Jesus—even when we feel discouraged. Before we learn how Paul shared the good news of Jesus, let's watch our video.

Unit 30: Power to Serve

Lesson 10: We can encourage others by sharing what Jesus has done for us. Before we learn how Paul shared his testimony, let's watch the video.

Lesson 11: We can use our faith in God to encourage others. Let's watch the video and notice the ways the students in the video shared their faith.

Lesson 12: The Bible equips us to serve others. Let's watch our video before we learn how Paul uses God's Word to encourage others.

Lesson 13: We can live each day for Christ! Let's watch our video, noticing the ways the students "stick with" serving Christ and others.
