Do Right

“Do not follow the crowd in doing wrong.”

Exodus 23:2

When we notice a character in a movie following the crowd to do wrong, I pause the movie or point it out to my kids later. To help them think through the consequences of such actions, I might ask, **What do you think might happen if that person continues to do this every day? What might that person’s life be like a year later?** I also affirm my kids when I see them choosing not to follow those who are doing wrong. I ask what helps them make those choices—and I listen and learn from them! I thank them for the good choices they are making and remind them, **God is glad to see you growing in this part of your life!**

Try This:

In addition to praying with your kids, let them know often that you are praying for them. “I prayed for you today that God would help you make good choices with your friends at school.” “I will pray that God will help you with the math test—He can help us remember what we’ve studied.” Over time, I have realized how much it means to my kids—because as they got older and were going out the door, they’d ask, “Mom, please pray for me today about ____.” Wow! I know they are depending on God.
